Training Highlights

Presented current research on access to victim of crime compensation for survivors of human trafficking.

Multiple trainings provided to law enforcement in collaboration with the Office of the Attorney General.

Presentation on CHNJ's new research on labor trafficking by forced criminality for the National Center on Safe Supportive Learning Environments.

Technical Assistance Highlights

Continued to support the implementation of screening for human trafficking across the Covenant House federation, resulting in 7 new sites utilizing QYIT.
